When you arrive at the Nash UNC Emergency Department, you'll be kept totally separate from patients with COVID-like symptoms. If you have COVID-like symptoms, you'll be placed in an isolated area set up especially for coronavirus patients.

In the waiting area, social distancing, hand hygiene and wearing masks is encouraged. All visitors are discouraged from accompanying patients beyond the waiting area. No visitors are allowed in the respiratory/COVID cohort unit. These are just a few of the measures we've put in place to help keep our patients, community and staff safe during this pandemic.
